# **Epsom & Ewell Phab Privacy Statement**

At Epsom & Ewell Phab we take your personal information, security and preferences seriously. We aim to be clear when we collect your data and not do anything you would not reasonably expect.

## Where do we collect information from?

- When you give it to us directly or via our website
- When you are referred to us by other organisations

#### What personal information do we collect

- Name, contact details and date of birth for members and volunteers
- Where necessary health details of members and volunteers
- Supporters contact details from events e.g. fundraising ball
- Contact details where you have asked to be kept informed about our activities
- · Address for gift aid

#### How we use it

- To provide appropriate care and help to members & volunteers
- To enable us to keep you informed about club activities
- To allow us to obtain gift aid where we have permission

## How do we manage members & volunteers data?

- Sensitive information will be obtained for members and volunteers when it is needed to ensure their safety and well-being whilst with Epsom and Ewell Phab
- Where appropriate, consent from a parent/guardian or carer will be obtained before collecting this
  information

### How do we keep your data safe and who has access?

- The storage of all our data is managed by our Data Protection officer
- Most data will be stored electronically password protected on a secure and protected server
- Paper medical forms/data will be kept secure and will be shredded when finished with
- Your data will not be sold or passed on to any third party for marketing or fundraising purposes
- · We may need to disclose your personal details to the emergency services if this is required
- We will only ever share your data in other circumstances if we have your explicit and informed consent e.g. holiday or activity venues.
- We would report any serious data breach to the ICO within 72 hours. In the event of your sensitive data being breached we will notify you of this without undue delay

#### How do we keep your information up-to date

- We would appreciate it if you would let us know if your contact details change
- We may contact you if we need to ensure we have your correct details on file
